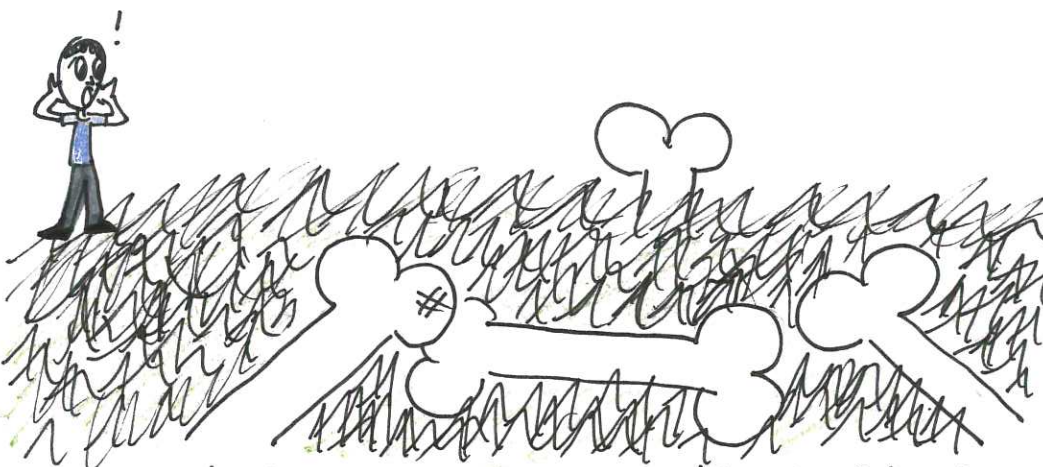
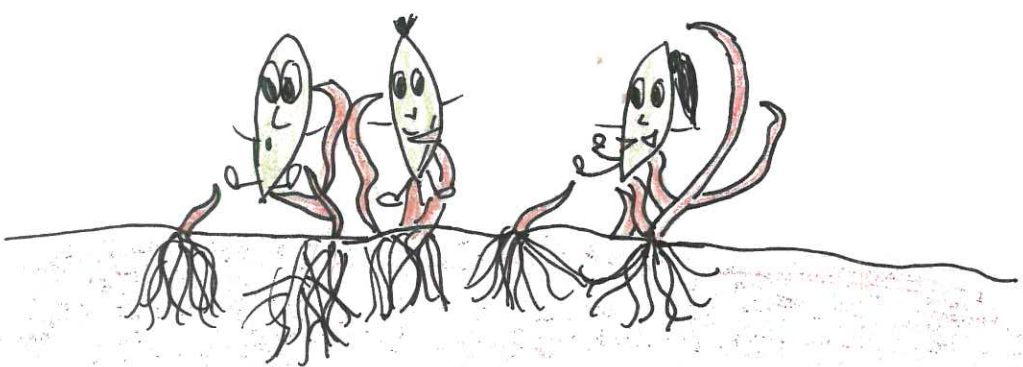


Figurative Language Artistic Representation Chart
