

### Instructions for Figurative Language Illustrations Project

- Divide a blank piece of paper into four equal sections
- In each quarter, you will choose one of the examples of each figurative language that you wrote down in your figurative language exercise
- Illustrate each example carefully. Use your imagination and be creative.
- Each illustration must be labeled with the type of figurative language you are depicting.
- Each illustration must include the quote
- All captions (type of figurative language and quote) must be neatly printed. Use a sharpie, a black pen or type them.
- The background of each illustration must be completely colored.
- You may want to outline your illustrations in black so they stand out against the color.

This project is worth 20 points. Use the checklist to ensure you have all the elements required.
