1. <b>they're</b> - they are <b>there</b> - a place <b>their</b> - ownership	<u>They're</u> going to win Put the chair <u>there</u> , please. Let's go to <u>their</u> house.
2. <b>you're</b> - you are <b>your</b> - ownership	<u>You're</u> such a helpful person Don't forget to do <u>your</u> homework.

7. <b>where</b> - a place <b>wear</b> - put on	<u>Where</u> were you yesterday? <u>Wear</u> warm clothes when you ski.
8. <b>know</b> - understand <b>no</b> - negative <b>now</b> - the present	I <u>know</u> how to write reactions. <u>No</u> , you shouldn't harass others. Start running the mile <u>now</u> .
9. <b>its</b> - ownership <b>it's</b> - it is	The rabbit escaped from <u>its</u> cage. <u>It's</u> non-negotiable!
10. <b>a lot</b> - it's <b>two</b> words!	We use these words <u>a lot</u> .
